of what I already had. God has given us so much. Realization is the first step, then comes acknowledgment.

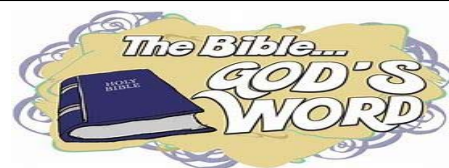

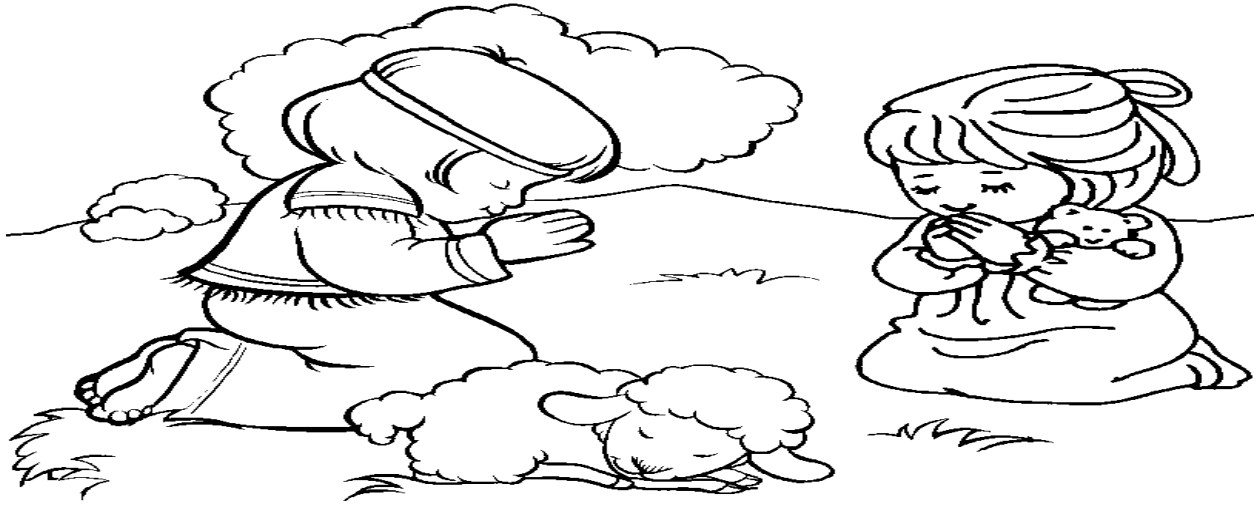


**REPORT FOR TWO CENTS - A - MEAL**
